Parent/volunteer Tuberculosis screening requirement

Dear Parents/volunteers,

California State law **requires** all individuals working/volunteering in the classroom or with students to have valid tuberculosis screening paperwork. Physician/registered Healthcare provider documentation is required. Please visit the MBUSD website for the proper forms and instructions:

Go to the bottom of this webpage and select the TB Questionnaire. Bring the **TB Questionnaire** form to your Doctor/registered Healthcare provider.

There will also be hard copies in the health office for parents to pick up.

You will need to have an approved registered healthcare provider fill out the TB Questionnaire; depending on your results, a skin test/chest x-ray may not be necessary. Please follow the instructions on the form and return the proper paperwork to the health office by **October 10,2017** the results are valid for four years.

Individuals without valid Tuberculosis documentation will be excluded from working on campus starting **October 10,2017** until valid documentation is received by the health office. Teachers will be given a list of approved parents/volunteers to work in their classrooms, if you aren't on the list you will not be able to volunteer on campus.

Please contact the health office if you are unsure if you have valid TB clearance to work on campus.

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
